**THE BREAD OF LIFE**

Since 1970 the Church has organized the Sunday scripture readings in a three-year cycle with each year featuring the gospel of either Matthew, Mark or Luke. Since Advent 2017 the Gospel of Mark has been at the forefront of our Sunday scripture readings; however, for the next several weeks, the Church will reflect upon the 6th chapter of John, which is frequently referred to as "the Bread of Life" discourse.

In John 6, Jesus addresses the crowd which has followed him into a deserted place in order to hear His preaching. Recognizing the hunger of the crowd, Jesus performs the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fish in order to provide earthly food to satisfy their hunger. Our Lord then resumes preaching and identifies Himself as "the Bread of Life". More than any empty feeling our stomachs may experience, there is a yearning in our hearts and souls for God. Jesus is the one who can satisfy the emptiness by filling us with His life and presence. Perhaps over the coming week we might pray and identify what we are yearning for in our lives, and place ourselves with our deepest hunger before the Lord.

**SIMBANG GABI AT ST. RAPHAEL**

Simbang Gabi is a Filipino custom of celebrating a series of liturgies in anticipation of Christmas. St. Raphael will host one of the liturgies on Saturday, December 22. I would like to meet with the members of the Filipino community here in order to begin organizing for December. Watch for an announcement of a meeting date and time in next week's bulletin.

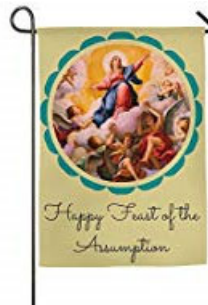

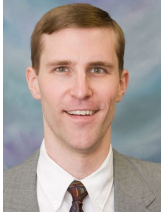
